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DUAL NETWORK PLAN

(HMO & PPO Extended Network)



University Family Care Plan includes TWO networks for your health care needs.

1. UNIVERSITY HEALTH NETWORK (HMO)

A large, high-quality, and reliable network of local doctors, specialists, and hospitals from University Health, University Medicine Associates (UMA) and UT Health San Antonio serving Bexar County and the seven surrounding counties

When accessing care from the University Health network, you'll experience fully coordinated care, plus the most cost-savings, including \$0 copays on covered services like x-rays, labs, and imaging.

2. FIRST HEALTH NETWORK (PPO)

Extended network offering managed out-of-pocket costs and national coverage on health care services across the **United States**

First Health has a \$625 individual/\$1,250 family deductible plus a 30% coinsurance after deductible on covered services. First Health network specialists do not require a referral.

Together, University Health Network and First Health Network provide you and your family both affordability and access.

DID YOU KNOW? If you currently see a provider who is NOT in the University Health network, you may still be able to see them after joining University Family Care Plan if they are part of the extended First Health Network.

Envolve vision benefits are included in your plan at no cost.

Envolve provides the following benefits:

- \$10 copay for annual eye exam
- Free lenses (single, bifocal, trifocal, or lenticular) for glasses
- \$125 allowance for frames or contact lenses every 24 months

If you need extra vision coverage, you may also elect to join the EyeMed Vision plan for an additional semi-monthly charge.

EyeMed provides the following benefits:

- Additional benefits and discounts for contact lenses and glasses
- Discount on Lasik or PRK procedures
